RCD Program Updates:

- **New COVID grant!:** An application and selection criteria were developed. A notice has been sent to producers and partner organizations.
- **Urban Streams Program**: USC has been instrumental in assisting two streamside residents in Marin over the last month including regulatory compliance and implementing Best Management Practices. As well, 15 landowners/stakeholders were assisted during the month of July that did not require site visits. USC supported MMWD in carrying out juvenile salmonid monitoring in absence of Greg Andrew. See Staff Report for more information.
- **Conserving Our Watersheds Program:** Two sites completed. Two sites are preparing for construction and need final permits. One site is held up by the County Coastal Permit process, and another site is awaiting NEPA approval. Staff expect construction season to begin mid-Aug Sept 2020. One project is cancelled.
- **Carbon Farming Program**: Preliminary results for the Marin County Climate Action Plan: Ag Chapter were presented at the Marin Conservation League Ag and Land Use Committee meeting. Several follow up presentations will be held for producer groups. Project design and budget underway for Straus hedgerow planting. Board to decide on how to allocate WCB design funds.
- Walker Creek Watershed: Road surveys are continuing in this watershed.
- Pine Gulch Creek Project: No activity
- Media/Outreach: No activity
- **Grant Opportunities:** Sarah is working on a potential grant proposal to remove pyrophytic plants.
  - o \$109,000. National Association of RCDs. North Coast Soil Health Coordinator. *Awarded*
  - o \$25,000. USDA Conservation Innovation Grant for training and education. *Pending*
  - o \$55,000. CA Wildlife Conservation Board for technical assistance. Pending
  - o \$430,000 DOC Stemple Creek Riparian Corridor Restoration. Pending
